  - b. 2" Milling, 0.5" Shim, and 1.5" Overlay Franklin Street to Washington Avenue
- 2. Congress Street Morning Street to Eastern Promenade
  - a. Install new ADA compliant brick sidewalk from Morning Street to the Eastern Promenade on the north side of the road
  - b. Loam and seed as needed due to this work

- 2. 0.5" hot mix asphalt shim
