**Outline of Work:** The work under this contract is to provide all labor, materials, and incidentals necessary for the Portland Fish Pier, Batter Pile Installation. The work includes, but is not necessarily limited to, providing fifty-two (52) new batter piles and providing other incidental work as may be shown on the plans and/or described in the specifications. The project includes a pay item for providing demolition of one hundred, seventy-three (173) panels of H-pile bracing. Award of this scope will be decided at the same time as the award of the batter pile installation.

### **MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE**

It is mandatory that all prospective bidders attend a pre-bid meeting in the net yard to the east of the Portland Fish Exchange freezer building (N 43.652709 W 70.253208) on Monday, November 21, 2022, at 2:00 P.M. Only those firms represented at this meeting may bid on the project.
