General Scope:

Commercial Fences and Walls

Examples of Types of Work:

Documents Required

Completed Building Permit Application (must include the following):
☐ Contact information with valid email address
 Accurate Job Value per ICC Building Value Data Table
Accurate, detailed scope of work
Letter of Authorization from the property owner designating an authorized agent to apply for the
permit.
Cover Sheet
☐ Code summary (include code editions); building features (include type construction etc.)
☐ Project narrative or description
 Scope of Work with detailed project description For projects of limited scope, highlight the area in the Scope of Work
☐ Index of drawings
<u>Flood Affidavit</u> signed by the owner and notarized if applicable. Only required if the property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area
3 copies of the Civil Site Plan must be submitted to Site Development <i>after</i> the 1st round of comments, including:
☐ Project Address or Parcel Description
☐ Current Survey
☐ Locations of proposed structure(s), driveway(s), sidewalk(s), and utilities on site
☐ Elevations and heights of the proposed fence. Walls, Caps, Piers, etc.
☐ Distances between proposed structures (s), existing structures, and property lines.
☐ Flood Zone identification and flood demarcation line if the property is a mixed region
☐ Existing conditions and associated site demolition/improvement plan
☐ Easements
☐ Irrigation Plan

☐ Landscape Plan to demonstrate buffer
 Location, species, and sizes of all trees in the work area
 Tree barricade locations and details.
Tree mitigation table
☐ If applicable, engineering plans for any construction trailer, related stairs & ramps (if open to public), electrical and plumbing connections.
3 copies of Construction Plans meeting plan review requirements -signed, sealed, and dated by a licensed Architect or Engineer in the state of Florida per Florida Building Code 107 that clearly indicate the entire scope of the project.
The following items will be required on the drawings:
☐ Property lines, the height, width, and length total square footage of the fence.
☐ Wall Cross Section
Provide the 20' width of vehicle gate for Fire Department access and other gate openings [electric or manual] (e.g., Electric Emergency Vehicle Access, Manual gate-
Knox Padlock Box, etc.)
