Why do we need to renovate the Playground?

The Park was built in 1974, and the playground was last updated with new playground equipment in 1995. The playground equipment has reached an age where it's difficult to find replacement parts if damage occurs, and the playground area is no longer fully compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Renovating the playground area allows Parks to bring all the equipment, access routes, furnishings and features up to code at one time, while addressing other issues such as erosion and drainage.

What other improvements will be made?

Project scope also includes

- Trail replacements and improvements to connect all park features north of the bridge
- Trail lighting replacement
- New picnic pavilion and tables
- New benches, seating, drinking fountain and trash receptacles
- New play equipment for children ages 2-12
- New drainage system throughout
- Tree planting
- New irrigation in playground area
