The Public Health Department uses the California Health Alert Network (CAHAN) to both receive urgent health alerts from the California Department of Health Services and communicate alerts and disaster information to healthcare partners. CAHAN is web-based system designed to broadcast alerts like an electronic phone tree, and is capable of sending alerts to its members by e-mail, phone, and fax.
