Sealed bids for the Maintenance Building Office Addition Residing Project at the Portland International Jetport shall be submitted electronically to bidsubmit@portlandmaine. govwith the name of the Bidder, Contract Name and Bid number in the subject line

will be received until 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 31, 2023, at which time they will be opened and read. Proposals may also be submitted in person or via USPS, UPS or FedEx to the City of Portland, Purchasing Rm. 103, 389 Congress St., Portland ME 04101. It is the bidder's sole responsibility to ensure that their bid is submitted prior to the date and time specified. Late bids shall not be accepted.

Location: Portland International Jetport 1001 Westbrook Street Portland, Maine 04102

Outline of Work: Removal of existing tile facade, windows, stair and landing and install new metal siding, windows and trim, and all other related work to complete the office addition residing project per the contract drawings and specifications.

Bid Note: Once the contractor mobilizes the entire project start to completion must be completed within 45 calendar days. It is anticipated that the contractor will receive authorization to proceed in the fall of 2023 (late November). The Contractor shall be prepared to mobilize within 3 weeks after award unless materials require longer lead time at which time the Contractor shall coordinate with the Jetport to mobilize as soon as materials are available.

As a result, the work will likely need to be completed in late fall or early winter. Contractor shall be responsible for temporary heat or other provisions necessary to complete the work during winter conditions. Liquidated damages will not be assessed, however, if this date is not achieved due to the critical nature of the airport operations the owner reserves the right to withhold money from the Contractor until such work is completed to the satisfaction of the owner.

Bonds: A bid bond is not required for the bid. 100% payment and performance bonds are required by the successful bidder prior to execution of a contract.

MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE

It is mandatory that all prospective contractors attend a pre-bid meeting that will be held at the Portland International Jetport. This meeting will be held at the Portland International Jetport. This meeting will be held in the Engineering Division conference room on the 2nd level (above baggage claim area) of the Jetport on Tuesday, October 10, 2023 at 11:00 A.M. Only those firms represented at

this meeting may bid on the project.
