

EVACUATION ORDER -- HURRICANE IAN

WHEREAS, significant local rainfall, wind, storm surge, and tornados are possible in Pasco County as a result of Hurricane Ian moving into and through the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, based on current forecast models and current expected strength, Hurricane Ian represents a potential threat to the lives and property of residents and businesses in Pasco County and elsewhere in the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Governor's Executive Orders 22-218 and 22-219, Pasco County Board of County Commissioners' Resolution No. 22-230, Chapter 252 of the Florida Statutes, Governor's Executive Order 80-29, Pasco County's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and Chapter 30, Article II, of the Pasco County Code of Ordinances, and under the direct authority of the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners, the undersigned on behalf of the Board and based on the information known or projected at this time, makes the following evacuation order in accordance with the Pasco County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan.

Pursuant to the authority recited above, the undersigned does hereby issue **mandatory evacuations** of the following persons/locations described below beginning Tuesday morning September 27, 2022:

- Persons residing in mobile/manufactured homes; and
- Persons residing in Evacuation Zone A; and
- Locations ordered evacuated by local authorities due to conditions those officials determine pose a threat to life, health, or safety; and
- Coastal low-lying areas, low lying areas along rivers, and inland areas which have experienced flooding in the past; and
- Persons residing in any structure that historically has experienced flooding as a result of significant and/or sustained rainfall events.

Pursuant to the authority recited above, the undersigned does hereby issue **recommended voluntary evacuations** of the following persons/locations described below beginning Tuesday morning September 27, 2022:

- Persons residing in Evacuation Zone B; and
- Persons residing in Evacuation Zone C; and
- Persons with special needs; and
- Persons vulnerable in the event of power loss.

Modifications to this order and/or maps identifying specific locations or areas for evacuation may be effectuated and/or identified by way of exhibit(s) attached to this Order. This Order and any supplemental exhibits will continue in effect until rescinded by an authorized person.

Persons subject to recommended or mandatory evacuation orders are encouraged to begin their preparation and evacuation as soon as possible.

SHELTERS FOR EVACUEES: Public shelters will open beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 27, 2022. Citizens should first attempt to find shelter with neighbors, relatives or friends. If that is not an option, citizens can self-evacuate directly to the shelter. Public shelter locations will be located at:
