YOR Place Lompoc is created in **partnership** with Santa Barbara County's contracted providers, a dedicated youth advisory group, and community stakeholders to **reduce the impact of the opioid and stimulant crisis on Lompoc's youth and families**. YOR Place provides **youth-driven community outreach, drop-in services**, and access to **prevention, intervention, treatment, medication for addiction treatment (MAT), and recovery services** for youth (ages 12-24) who are misusing opioids and/or stimulants.

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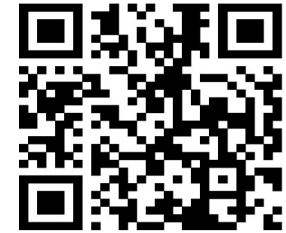
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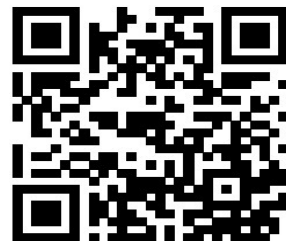
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
