 UNSIGNED IDENTIFICATION ENVELOPE STATEMENT AND INSTRUCTIONS**

**READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE STATEMENT.
 FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY CAUSE YOUR VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT NOT TO COUNT.**

1. You did not sign your vote-by-mail ballot identification envelope or provisional ballot identification envelope. In order to ensure that your vote-by-mail ballot or provisional ballot will be counted, an Unsigned Identification Envelope Statement must be completed and returned as soon as possible, but no later than 5 p.m. two days prior to certification of the election.
2. You must sign your name where specified on the Statement (Voter's Signature) and include your address.
3. Place your completed Statement into your own envelope with sufficient postage. Mail, deliver, or have your completed statement delivered to the elections official.
4. If you do not wish to send your completed Statement by mail or have it delivered, you may submit your completed Statement by email to Votebymail2@countyofsb.org or fax it to **1 (805) 681-4003** or **1 (805) 568-2209**, or submit your completed Statement to a polling place within Santa Barbara County or a ballot drop-off box before the close of polls on Election Day.
NOTE: Secure Ballot Drop Boxes and Polling Place Locations will close at 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
5. Please note that the signature provided on the completed Statement may be added to your registration record to be used for signature comparison purposes in future elections.

I understand that if I commit or attempt any fraud in connection with voting, or if I aid or abet fraud or attempt to aid or abet fraud in connection with voting, I may be convicted of a felony punishable by imprisonment for 16 months or two or three years.</p> <p>I understand that my failure to sign this Statement means that my vote-by-mail or provisional ballot will be invalidated.</p>
