# Effective January 1, 2022 Minimum Wage in the City of Portland is \$13.00 per hour

# Service Employees

- A service employee is someone who regularly receives more than \$100 a month in tips.
- An employer may consider tips as part of a service employee's Minimum Wage.
- An employer must pay tipped workers a "direct wage" of at least \$6.50 cash per hour.
- If a service employee's direct wage and total tips <u>do not</u> equal or exceed \$13.00 per hour, the employer must pay the service employee the difference.

## **Applicability of State Law**

- Employers must still comply with all labor laws of the State of Maine, as detailed in Title 26. This includes:
  - Which workers are eligible for overtime pay;
  - Notice to employees.
