A voter completing an application designating a third party to pick up and return the ballot - the Envelope must be signed by two witnesses	Bring the application to the City Clerk's Office- Rm. 203 389 Congress St. Portland, ME 04101	Mail or in person by voter or in person by the same third party

Absentee requests and absentee voting in the City Clerk's office will end at 7:00 P.M. on the Thursday prior to Election Day.

**Deadline to return all absentee ballots:
All absentee ballots must be returned by 8:00 P.M. on Election Night**
