The Neighborhood Partnership Program heavily incentivizes neighborhoods to organize and work together for a common goal. For most projects, neighborhood activity can be used to offset the project's total cost.

Unique to this program, the City of Farmers Branch will use its professional staff, financial resources, and project managers to ensure successful projects and lasting outcomes.

NEIGHBORHOOD PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM



- Download the application from the City website at farmersbranchtx.gov/NPP
- Review application requirements and contact Economic Development for assistance 972.919.2507
- Review the projects financial obligation and clearly define how the neighborhood will provide the financial match for the project.
- Complete and sign the NPP application
- Include all supporting documentation including photographs, quotes, maintenance agreements, plans, maps, and any other project information you have available.
- Submit application and supporting materials by April 30 or October 31.
- Completed applications will be reviewed by staff and a formal recommendation will be made to City Council within 90 days. It is highly recommended that you begin working with Economic Development prior to the deadline - Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Once the project is approved, City staff will begin working with the point of contact for the neighborhood.
- The neighborhood match must be received within one year of the project's approval or the project will be cancelled.
